

Introduction to Bible Doctrines - Syllabus

Course Description: Ostrobothnia Bible School provides basic teachings of the Christian faith. The course is a general survey of biblical doctrines, outlining major areas of systematic theology

1. Introduction to Doctrine: The Bible
2. Introduction to Doctrine: God (Divine Attributes and Trinity)
3. Introduction to Doctrine: God and Creation
4. Introduction to Doctrine: Christ
5. Introduction to Doctrine: The Holy Spirit
6. Introduction to Doctrine: Angels, Satan, Demons
7. Introduction to Doctrine: Man and Sin
8. Introduction to Doctrine: Salvation
9. Introduction to Doctrine: The Church
10. Introduction to Doctrine: The Future

Examination:

1. Reading the Study of the respective doctrine
2. Oral Examination with the instructor, based on which a student will be assigned to write a reflection paper.
3. The Bible reading. Please see the assigned Bible reading on the last page of the respective doctrine
4. Reflection paper from each doctrine. The length is 1 page, font size 11.
